EQUANS will provide maintenance and services for a diverse range of equipment including the thermal plant and its chiller and steam boilers; non-comfort ventilation to specialist laboratory areas; and the pressure controlled P1, P2 and P3 laboratories area; infection control rooms; medical vacuum pumps; and refrigeration services.

EQUANS will also provide maintenance to the electrical distribution system, including generators and UPS; the full fire detection and suppression systems; and the annual fire, water and electrical certifications for the facility.

"We have a great deal of respect for the Victor Chang Cardiac Research Institute, and we're looking forward to bringing our expertise in facilities management to its operations" says Mr Guédel.
